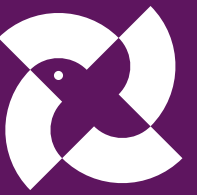

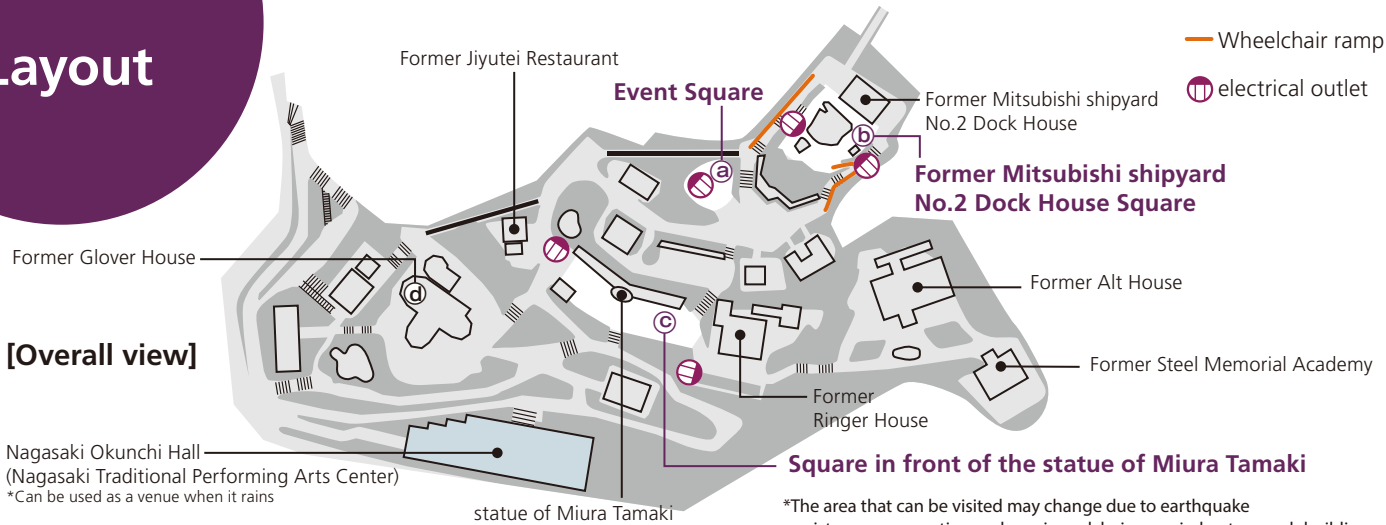

Glover Garden has a variety of unique outdoor venues, such as Square in front of the statue of Miura Tamaki, Former Mitsubishi shipyard No.2 Dock House Square, the event square, the Fountain of Prayer, Former Steel Memorial Academy, and more, making it a great place to hold an impressive party. In case of rain, you can also hold the party indoors at the Nagasaki Okunchi Hall (Nagasaki Traditional Performing Arts Center), which is about 400 m² in size.

Historical Story

The former residences of foreign merchants such as Glover, Ringer, and Alt, who came to Nagasaki during the end of the Tokugawa shogunate, have been preserved. The historic buildings have been relocated to Glover Garden and is now an open-air museum.

A mix of Western, Chinese and Japanese influences have created a culture unique to Nagasaki thanks to the exclusive influx of foreign culture. Glover Garden, where the residences of foreign merchants are gathered, is a place of great historic significance. It is a popular must-see stop for visitors to Nagasaki and has an impressive and unique list of venues, with a number of flexible spaces that can accommodate a variety of events and functions.

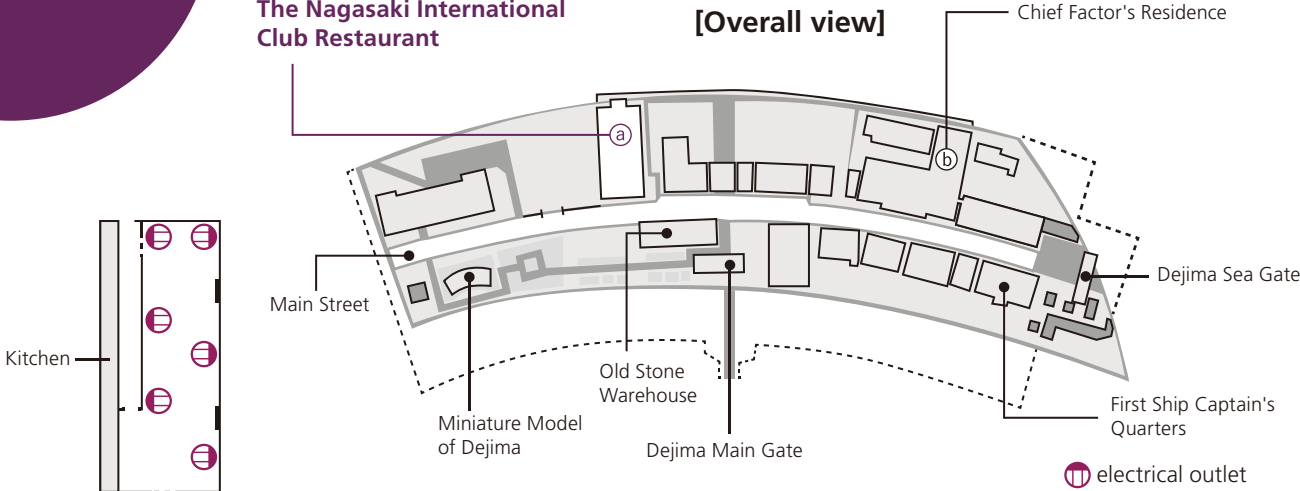

Historical Story

Dejima is a fan-shaped artificial island. During the 200 years when trade was closed off due to national isolation, Dejima was Japan's only window to Europe. Dejima played a major role in the modernization of Japan, as various goods were imported through trade with the Netherlands.

Nagasaki City has been engaged in the Dejima Restoration Project for a long time. Some of the buildings have been fully restored and are open to the public. The main street is lined with warehouses and buildings where the trading company staff lived. Experience the atmosphere and the activities of Dejima as well as the style and decor of the times, for example in the "Chief Factor's Residence" used by the head of the Dutch trading post. Additionally, the venue, The Nagasaki International Club Restaurant, will offer a menu that is typical Nagasaki cuisine.

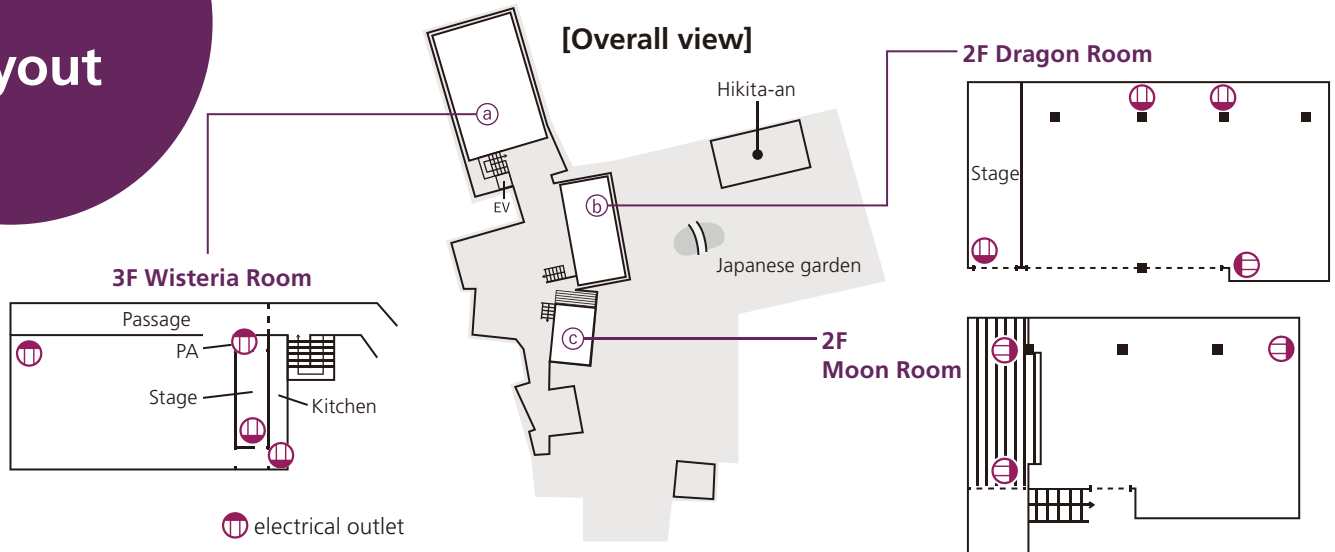

During the Edo period (1603-1868), Maruyama prospered as one of the “three great Geisha districts of Japan”, alongside Edo’s Yoshiwara and Kyoto’s Shimabara. With an air of glamour and solemnity, this former Geisha headquarter will make your heart skip a beat.

Kagetsu, an historical ryotei, served as the social hub for samurai revolutionaries and literati alike in the 19th century. Ryu-no-ma still bears the mark of Ryoma Sakamoto’s sword, and the gardens maintain their solemn beauty. The spacious Fuji-no-ma can accommodate 130 people. The Tsuki-no-ma, loved by Kaishu Katsu, is also highly recommended. Step back to a time of tradition, hospitality and Japanese historical figures for a truly unique Nagasaki experience.

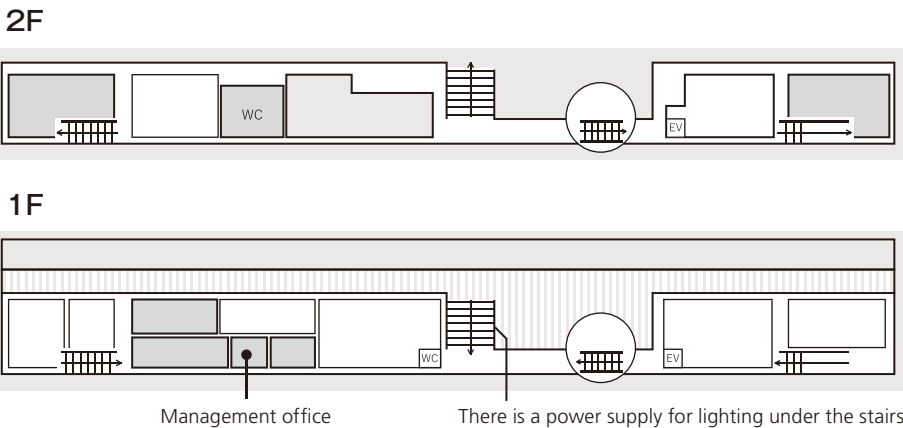
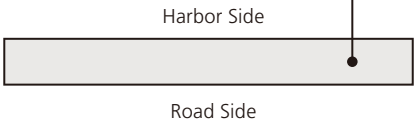

Historical Story

The Nagasaki Port is also known as the “Port of the Crane” as the port looks like a crane spreading its wings. It has been functioning as a gateway to the world ever since Nagasaki opened the port to foreign trading ships in the 16th century. Nagasaki was the only port open to the world during Japan's isolation period in the 17th-19th century, and as such has played an important role in Japanese history.

Dejima Wharf is right by the sea. It is literally four or five steps from the restaurant area. As such, you can dine while ships ferry to and from right in front of you. Another unique feature is that the big wharf area is flexible and can accommodate groups of various sizes. Restaurants, bars and cafes are available for smaller groups, while larger groups of up to 1,000 people are welcome to the whole area, or the first and second floors separately. The Triangle Plaza next to the street is also available as a venue.

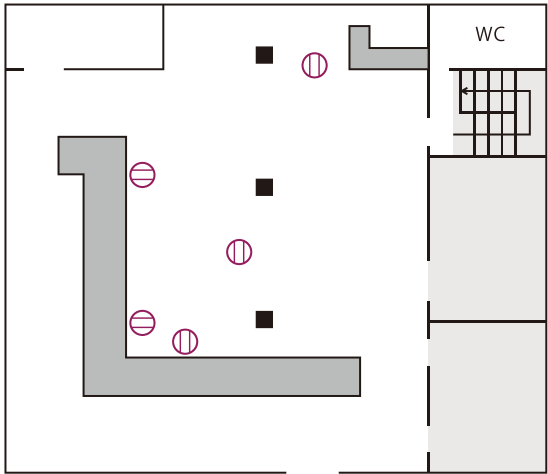

Historical Story

Near the end of the Edo period, the Nagasaki branch of the Hong Kong and Shanghai Bank was established. Designed by Kikutaro Shimoda, a great architect of the Meiji and early Showa eras. It has undergone various transitions and has been restored to its original form.

The multi-purpose hall on the first floor with gorgeous decorations from the Meiji era, faithfully recreates the atmosphere. Experience the dignified retro-modern ambiance and the leading architectural style of the time. Though listed as a National Important Cultural Property, it is also flexible and well suited for events and functions of any kind.

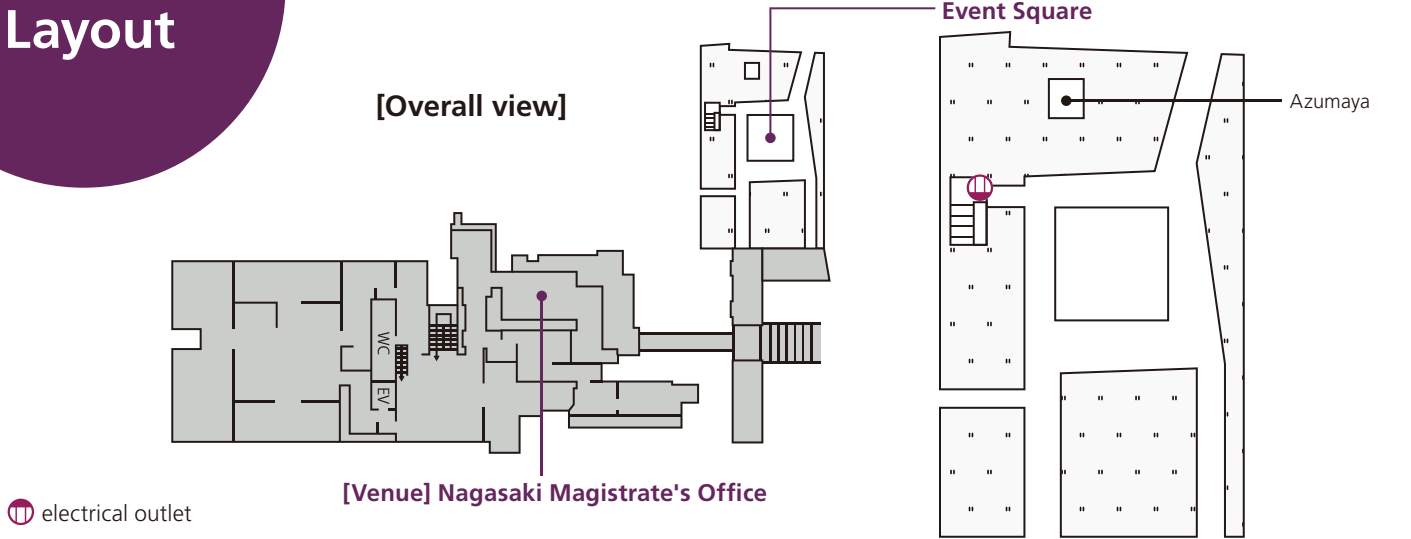

The Nagasaki Magistrate's Tateyama Office was once located here. Reenactments of court trials are held in the Magistrate's Office Zone. Suwa Shrine, where the Nagasaki Kunchi Festival is held, is also nearby.

The museum's theme is the "History of Overseas Exchange", which makes its Event Square perfect as a unique venue for multi-national events and functions. There is an adjacent lawn that is also available for various events. In the restored Nagasaki Magistrate's Office, events such as trial reenactments are held on Sundays.

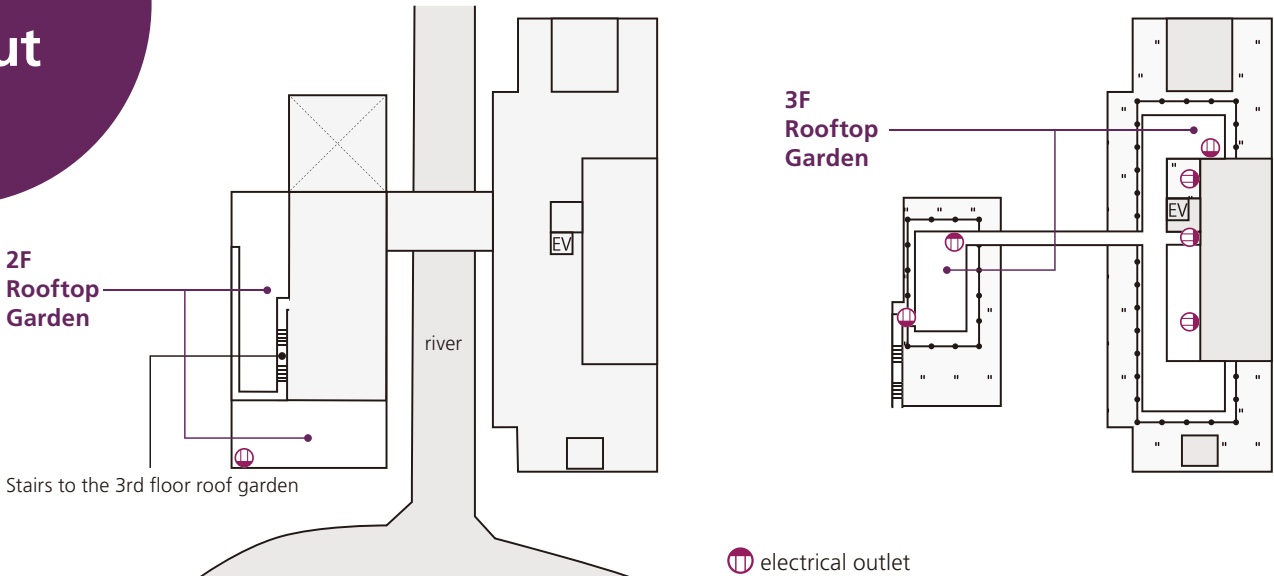

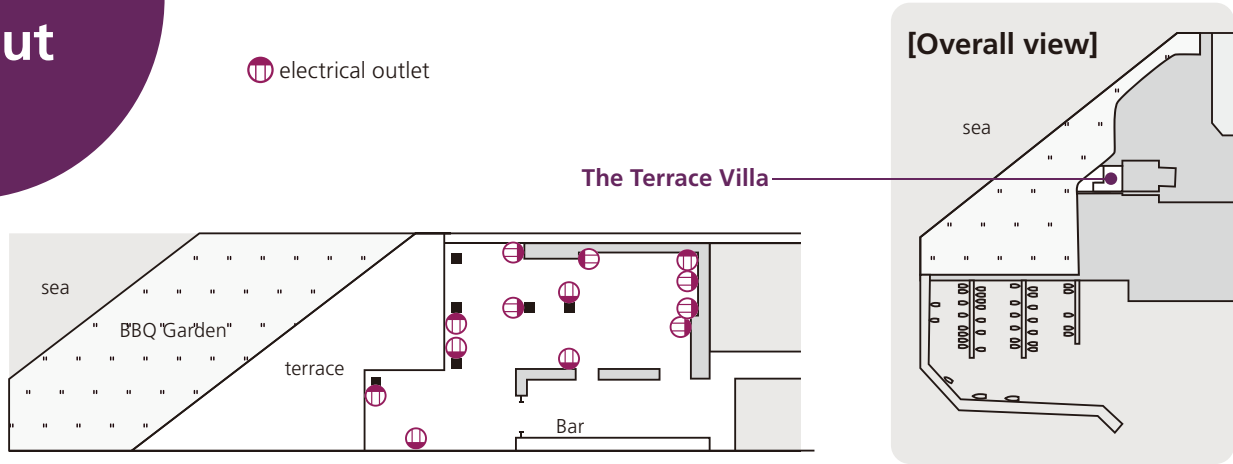

Historical Story

To the west of Nagasaki City and facing the Sumonada Sea, the Fukuda district was once a port for the Nanban trade (trades between Japan and the West). In the 1960s, the district turned into a lively place, and it was commonly known as the amusement park of Fukuda. Today, the region centers around "Nagasaki Sunset Marina", a resort where you can experience and enjoy various marine activities.
